



Algeria Brings about Revision in IP Fees

Algeria's National Institute of Industrial Property (INAPI) has updated official IP fees for 2026 following amendments introduced in the 2026 Finance Law. The new schedule was published in the Official Gazette and affects a wide range of IP procedures.

The fee revision goes beyond trademarks and patents and also applies to examining and formal procedures, publication and issuance of titles, renewals and recordal actions (assignments, changes etc).

These adjustments align administrative charges with new fiscal and regulatory needs as set by the Finance Law.

VAT on IP Official Fees

Separately, since March 29, 2024, a 19% VAT is applied on official fees for IP services in Algeria (e.g., filings, renewals). This VAT applies even to pending cases where further payments are due, increasing the total cost of IP services.

These changes are part of Algeria's broader fiscal adjustments under recent finance laws, aimed at modernizing IP administration and aligning fee structures with current economic requirements.
