



## **Libya Resumes Electronic Trademark Publications**

In a notable development for trademark owners and practitioners, the Libyan Commercial Registry Department has resumed the electronic publication of trademarks through its official online platform after a period of suspension.

The latest publication includes approximately 500 trademarks, covering trademark application numbers 55261 to 57597. The resumption of online publication restores an important stage in the trademark registration process, providing greater visibility and transparency regarding pending trademark rights in Libya.

Under the applicable trademark regulations, published marks are subject to a 30-day opposition period, during which interested parties may challenge the registration of a trademark.

While the relaunch of the publication system is a positive step toward improving the administration of trademark matters, a substantial number of trademark applications that were previously accepted remain unpublished. In particular, numerous accepted applications bearing numbers preceding 55261 are yet to appear on the portal, creating uncertainty for applicants awaiting the completion of the registration process.

Stakeholders are closely monitoring developments and engaging with the Commercial Registry Department to obtain further clarity regarding the publication schedule and the treatment of pending applications. The continued rollout of trademark publications is expected to be closely watched by brand owners seeking to secure and enforce their rights in the Libyan market.

The resumption of electronic publications signals progress in the modernization of Libya's trademark system and is likely to enhance transparency and accessibility for rights holders and practitioners alike.
